Standard Tour #5 (8 nights / 10 days)

Day 1

Departure via scheduled airline service to Munich, Germany

Day 2 Munich / Dachau (D)

Arrive in Munich

Meet your MCI Tour Manager, who will assist the group to awaiting chartered motorcoach for sightseeing

Visit Dachau, the former Nazi concentration camp (see an English film in Dachau)

Late afternoon hotel check-in

Evening Welcome Dinner and overnight

Munich, the Bavarian capital, is ideally located in southern Germany near the Alps. It is a first-class cultural center and the most flourishing economic zone in the southern part of the country. Munich's cultural wealth, its special atmosphere - a blend of gaiety, tolerance and respect for tradition - and the beauty of the surrounding countryside have combined to make it one of the most appreciated of German cities

Day 3 Munich (B,D)

A guided tour of Munich includes the Marienplatz (with its famous Glockenspiel), Frauenkirche, Hofbräuhaus (best-known of all German beer halls), and the English Gardens

Performance as part of the American Celebration of Music in Germany

Day 4 Munich / Neuschwanstein (B,D)

A full-day tour through the Bavarian Alps includes Neuschwanstein Castle (made famous by the Walt Disney model in Anaheim), built by the infamous Ludwig II (including entrance and uphill transport). Also visit the charming Wieskirche (Church in the Meadow) and Oberammergau, the site of the world famous Passion Play which is performed every 10 years Return to Munich for dinner and overnight

Day 5 Munich / Heidelberg (B,D)

Transfer to Heidelberg. A half-day tour of Germany's oldest university town includes the Schloß (castle) offering a splendid view of the city beneath. In the castle, see the Great Barrel, the Courtyard and the Pharmaceutical Museum. Also see the old university itself, the Cathedral of the Holy Ghost, the Old Bridge and the Jesuit Church. This is an enchanting city in which to stroll!

The jewel of the Neckar River is Heidelberg, with town, castle and wooded hills rising above the river. A close runner-up to the castle is Germany's oldest university forever immortalized in The Student Prince. It is as delightful as any operetta with its student inns, student prison and the narrow streets of the old town. There are a variety of boat trips available from Heidelberg on some of the loveliest stretches of the Neckar and Rhine Rivers














Board a Rhein River Cruise at Rüdesheim. On the cruise, see high hills stretching away from the river, topped with romantic and legendary castles, churches, vineyards and charming, old world towns surrounded by fortified walls, towers and gates

Disembark in St. Goar and return to Heidelberg via motorcoach for a performance as part of the American Celebration of Music in Germany Dinner and overnight



Transfer to Paris

Time permitting; visit stop at Reims to visit the Cathedral

> Half-day guided tour of Paris historique, including Notre-Dame Cathedral, Arc de Triomphe, Eiffel Tower, Champs Elysees, Place de la Concorde, Luxembourg Palace and Gardens, Latin Quarter, Place de la Bastille, and other highlights


Day 9 **Paris**

Day 10 Depart for home **(B)**
