· Depart from USA gateways via scheduled air service Dublin, Ireland

Day Two: Friday, June 20

- Arrive in Dublin
- Meet your MCI Tour Manager who will assist the group to awaiting chartered motorcoach for a panoramic tour of Dublin City including a visit to EPIC Ireland, the Irish Emigration Museum
- Visit the Guinness Storehouse
- Evening transfer to Taylor's Three Rock for a Welcome Dinner and Irish night including singing, dancing and good old Irish "craic"
