From Paul Revere's midnight ride to the Boston Massacre, this city brings the story of America's fight for independence vividly to life around every cobblestone corner.

#### DAY ONE : FRIDAY, MAY 29, 2026

- Self-guided tour of Bunker Hill Monument and the USS Constitution, "Old Ironsides"
- Afternoon rehearsal (3 hours)
- Dinner at a local restaurant
- Return to the hotel for overnight

- Visit the JFK Library to see its iconic architecture and view the many original papers and correspondence of the Kennedy Administration. Step back into the re-created world of the early 1960's and experience first-hand the life and legacy of John and Jacqueline Kennedy

- Dinner at a local restaurant or boxed dinner
- Evening Performance
