Taking place every July in Vienna's two main classical concert venues, the **Golden Hall of the Musikverein** and the **Wiener Konzerthaus**, the festival offers a truly international environment where a thousand young musicians speak the universal language of music, enjoy intercultural exchanges and build bridges that span continents.

Being one of the few festivals designed for choirs, bands and orchestras at the same time, the SCL Youth Music Festival offers a variety of options: Ensembles may participate either in the Competition or in the non-competitive Celebration. In addition to the competition or celebration we offer workshops within the SCL Academy. Top professionals form the international juries in the Competition and teach our Academy program at the Vienna University of Music.

Enjoy interactive workshops and educational lectures, additional concerts with local audiences, and pre-and post-concert tours in Europe.

- Day 4: Individual concerts and performances in and around Vienna Choir, orchestra and band workshops at the University of Music in Vienna



The New Jersey Youth Symphony recently participated in the Summa Cum Laude International Youth Music Festival in Vienna (SCL). Our trip was coordinated through Music Celebrations International. **Of all the tours and experiences I've had with music and young people, this trip is at the top of the list.** The experience of performing in historic concert halls, and absorbing the musical heritage of the area, has elevated our students to the next level in every way.

The festival began with a meeting of all participants (1,600!) in St. Stephen's Cathedral in Vienna. Ensembles from 14 different countries participated, and a representative from each group presented a statement before the packed cathedral. It was an impressive event in a stunning venue. We also performed two additional concerts at the MuTH, home of the Vienna Boys Choir, and in a beautiful country town to very enthusiastic concert goers. SCL also provided workshops with internationally renowned conductors which was educational and inspiring.

I strongly recommend this experience for any serious youth ensemble. It will change your life.
